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Supply List:



Fabrics in light and dark fabrics for the flowers and leaves

For flowers:

- Cut squares of 5", 4", and 3.5" from each light and dark you have for the flowers

For leaves and stems:

- Cut 1 - 1 1/2 x 20" bias strips for stems
- Cut 2 - 2 1/2" X 8" of both light and dark fabric
- Cut 2 - 2 1/2" x 10" of both light and dark fabric

You will also require:

- Freezer paper – minimum of 2" X 8" strip and 2 x 10" strip
- 1 sheet of letter size paper
- Thread to match flower colour
- Hand sewing needle, scissors
- Iron
- Sewing machine
- A background block – size whatever you choose. I would suggest that you have a pre-quilted background to applique the flowers to, this gives the applique sufficient stability for the flowers – this will be discussed in the workshop.

Instructions

For the flowers:

- Using light and dark of the same size, sew with your machine, completely around the block. (You may want an opening for turning, and after you will need to close it. I don't, I sew it all closed and open a hole to turn with my Quilter's snap (or tweezers) – I will demo this during the class)
- Press the blocks after turning.

For the leaves:
