An RCQG Summer Mystery Quilt

Clue #3–Four-Patch Units

Cutting for Clue #3

From Background Fabric:

- Cut six (6) 2” strips WOF.

From Fabric #5:

- Cut six (6) 2” strips WOF.

Piecing for Clue #3

1. Sew each background 2” strip to a Fabric #5 2” strip selvedge to selvedge. Press toward fabric #5.
2. Place one sewn strip set on top of a second strip set right sides together so that the background fabric is against fabric #5 on each side. Run your fingers along the strip making sure that the seams are nesting everywhere.
3. Cut 2” sets along the strips to get sixty (60) pairs of two patches. DO NOT SEPARATE THE PIECES.
4. Sew each set together to make a four-patch block checking that the seams are nesting. Spin the centre when pressing.
