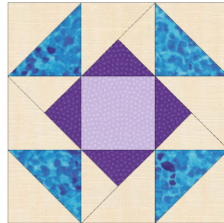


Triangles at Play

An RCQG Summer Mystery Quilt

Clue #4 – Block A



Cutting for Clue #4

From Fabric #2:

- Cut two (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips WOF.
 - Subcut into fifteen (15) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Piecing for Clue #4

1. Divide the HSTs from Clue #1 into four (4) equal piles of fifteen.
2. Divide the Split Half-Square Triangles from Clue #1 into four (4) equal piles of fifteen as well.
3. Arrange HSTs, split half-square triangles and the fifteen $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a nine-patch arrangement as illustrated.
4. Sew the blocks together in rows pressing towards the four (4) corner blocks and the centre square. Then, sew the rows together nesting seams and spinning them when pressing.
5. Block A should measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square unfinished.
